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**Brief Description of Program:**

The purpose of the Care Coordination for Children (CC4C) Program is to assist families to identify and utilize health care resources needed to meet needs of children ages birth to five. Special emphasis is given to serving children who have chronic illnesses, disabling conditions or developmental delays, or those who are at particular risk for these conditions, and children who are exposed to toxic stress. Program funds are used to provide these services to children with no other third party coverage (e.g. Medicaid) for these services. Services are provided using Medicaid guidelines for same services for Medicaid program participants. [G.S. 130A-124]
