Brief Description of Program:

The Demonstration Grant is a grant using state funds for the bi-annual High Point International Home Furnishes Market. A contract for transportation services for the Market shall be secured through a collaborative process between the City of High Point and the Market Authority, in compliance with local, state, and federal guidelines, for execution by the City of High Point and the Contractor. The transportation services are provided by a third-party contractor.

The North Carolina General Assembly provides funding yearly for the furniture market for the purposes of providing transportation to the visitors. The Integrated Mobility Division has designated the City of High Point to be the recipient of the funds. According to the Memorandum of Agreement between the City of High Point and the Market Authority, the transportation provider will submit periodic invoices and documentation to the Market Authority and after approval by the City of High Point, the Market Authority will reimburse the contractor for the expenses incurred in accordance with the Grant Agreement. After the expenses have been paid to the contractor the City of High Point will submit a claim in EBS for reimbursement.
